

Some UNIX Navigation Commands

- cd** Change Directory (folder)
example: `cd /home/gcullen`
- pwd** Discover which directory you are currently at.
- cd ..** Change directory by backing up the file tree by 1 level.
- ls** Display directories and files (with attributes).
Example: `ls -lsta`
- cp** Make a Copy of a file
`cp <source> <target> -pr`
- rm** Remove or Delete a file: `rm <filename.file_ext>`
Removing a hidden file: `rm <.filename.file_ext>`
- exit** Terminate and logout your session
- man** Get the documentation on a command
`man <some_command>`
- Ctrl+C** Kill the process running in foreground

*Notes: (1) UNIX is case-sensitive.
(2) Any letters following the "-" (dash) are command options.
(3) **Do not include the "<>" in the line command.***
